### Description of method:

Strategical thinking is a difficult topic to understand for students and Activity-based learning helps students to understand this concept well. This activity “Survival Activity” means taking decisions that will affect the survival. Each student participates individual and then in team. First, each student is given a real-life scenario like they are stuck in desert. Now they have around 15 items which they can carry for their survival. List of items is given. Now each of the students should think critically about the utility of the item and prioritize them. The same is repeated with group of four students. Difference in their thinking is observed and then discussed. This will give the students to think on wider perspective and take decisions.

Innovative Methods like this are used to make students do and understand.

### Benefits of method:

This activity allows them to think critically and analyse the various options and their pros and cons. Make well informed decisions.
