Agenda 01: Academic activities during lockdown period

- Dr. Bindu S, presented a detailed report of online classes conducted during lockdown period with the sample copies of timetable. Pre-recorded videos of laboratory experiments were also displayed to the committee.
- Apart from academics' major importance was given to student and faculty counselling, a detailed report of faculty interaction with Dean, Prof. Eishwar N.
