## Proceedings of the Governing Body meeting, BNMIT

Chairperson Sri. Narayan Rao R. Maanay welcomed all the members of the Governing Body (GB) and requested the member secretary to read out the agenda and the members to deliberate on the subjects listed.

 Perusal of action taken report and approval of the proceedings of the previous GB meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

Suggestion 1: To introduce Mega Flagship Projects of interdisciplinary nature.

**Action taken:** The efforts are on and the flagship projects will be launched and implemented from the Academic year 2022-23.

**Suggestion 2:** To increase the intake of B.E. in Computer Science and Engineering from the existing 120 to 180 from the Academic Year 2022-23.

**Action taken:** Application was made to increase intake of B.E. in Computer Science and Engineering from the existing 120 to 180 to VTU, AICTE and Government of Karnataka and approval was obtained from all these bodies and the same has been reflected in the seat matrix of KEA for the Academic year 2022-23.

**Suggestion 3:** To update the syllabus of EEE and ME by adding the latest technologies like AIML, Python, IOT, Modelling and Simulation, Linux, Web Programming with JAVA, DBMS, Big Data, ANN, Block Chain, Mechatronics System Design, Robotics, Data Structures and Machine Learning etc.

Action taken: The suggestion has been implemented.

**Suggestion 4:** To check whether offering five-year integrated degree for B.E. with M.Tech, can improve admission for M.Tech.

**Action taken:** VTU is yet to give the approval to offer integrated degree for B.E. with M.Tech. As of now VTU has permitted to offer integrated degree for M.Tech with Ph.D.

Chairperson asked whether any comments were received on the proceedings of the previous meeting from the members of the Governing Body. Principal replied that no comments were received from any of the Governing Body members. Hence the following resolution was passed.

Resolution: The Governing Body noted and appreciated action taken on suggestions made during the previous Governing Body meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022. All the proceedings of the previous meeting were confirmed unanimously as presented.

## 2. Approval of proceedings of the Finance Committee

Sri. Narayan Rao. R Maanay, Chairperson requested the Director and Principal to present the proceedings of the Finance Committee meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2022. The Director and Principal presented the proceedings of the Finance Committee.

Resolution: The Governing Body noted status of construction of Allied (New) Block, ratified all the purchases, expenditures made so far for the construction of Allied (New) Block. The Governing Body approved all the proceedings of the Finance Committee (Annexure-1) meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2022.

## 3. Results of 1st year Autonomous batch

Additional Director informed the committee that BNMIT has adopted first of its kind paperless assessments (examinations) for the autonomous batches (for internal as well as semester end assessments). Principal presented the results of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semesters assessments (examination) to the committee.

Resolution: The Governing Body noted the results and expressed happiness for having conducted the exams without compromising on the quality and setting a benchmark for autonomous institutions in this regard.

## 4. Ratification of the appointment of Faculty and Non-Teaching staff

Chairperson presented to the Governing Body the proceedings of the meeting of Board of Appointment regarding the appointment of staff members made during the period from 29<sup>th</sup> March 2022 to 11<sup>th</sup> October 2022. The UGC Nominee Dr. Rajender Nath asked Principal whether the newly appointed Faculty members meet the eligibility requirements. Principal replied that they all meet the eligibility criteria of AICTE.

Resolution: The Governing Body ratified the appointment of Faculty and Non-Teaching staff members made during the period mentioned above (Annexure-2).

## 5. Any other subject with permission of the Chair.

## a. Scheme and Syllabus of first and second year and scheme of other higher semesters

Additional Director and Dean informed the Governing Body that the scheme and syllabus has been revised for the academic year 2022-23 to meet the ever changing requirements of the Industry and presented the scheme of all semesters of B.E. and MBA and syllabus of 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> semesters of B.E. and all 4 semesters of MBA as approved by the BOS and Academic Council.

Resolution: The Governing Body appreciated the efforts.

## b. Renewal of NBA Accreditation

Principal informed the Governing Body about the renewal of accreditation by NBA for 3years from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025 for 5 branches of Engineering. He also informed GB that the committee has actually recommended for 6years of accreditation and the credit goes to the dedicated faculty and non-teaching staff who have worked tirelessly beyond the call of duties.

Resolution: The Governing Body expressed happiness about the Extension of NBA Accreditation.

## c. First Year Scorecards(Autonomous) on National Academic Depository.

Principal gave an insight into the National Academic Depository and informed the GB that it is mandatory to upload the scorecards of Autonomous batch students as per the guidelines of UGC and VTU. He also mentioned the scorecards will be uploaded by the end of Oct/Nov 2022.

Resolution: The Governing Body noted and appreciated the same.

d. Opening of new account for International Conference and renaming of department accounts.

Director, Additional Director and Principal requested the Governing Body to give permission to open a new account for the International Conference **IITCEE** scheduled to be held at BNMIT during January 2023. They also requested the GB to give permission to rename/open the following 8 accounts.

- 5. BNMIT ABEEE to BNMIT-EEE for Electrical and Electronics Engineering Department

### **New Accounts**

- 1. BNMIT-ISE for Information Science and Engineering Department
- 2. BNMIT-AIML for Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning Department

Principal requested the GB to give permission to operate all the above accounts jointly by the Principal and the HOD of the respective department.

3. BNMIT-IITCEE for IEEE International Conference (Scheduled during January 2023)

Additional Director requested the GB to give permission to operate the above account jointly by the Dr. S.Y. Kulkarni, Additional Director and Dr. S.K. Niranjan, Head, ASTEP- Association for Science & Technology Education Promotion.

Resolution: The Governing Body gave permission to open three new accounts and rename the existing five accounts mentioned above. Further, the GB resolved that the first 7 accounts shall be jointly operated by the Principal and the HOD of the respective department, and BNMIT-IITCEE account shall be jointly operated by Dr. S.Y. Kulkarni, Additional Director and Dr. S.K. Niranjan, Head, ASTEP- Association for Science & Technology Education Promotion. GB also resolved that new account can be opened for International Conferences as and when required to be ratified in the subsequent GB meeting to avoid delays.


