Possible Roles:

- 1. Opening speaker
- 2. Rebuttal speaker
- 3. Concluding speaker
- 4. Leader
- 5. Speech composer
- 6. Researcher
- 7. Organizer
- 8. Debate moderator

Possible sources of information:

- 1. Peer-reviewed journal articles,
- 2. Books and manuscripts
- 3. Magazines and newspaper articles
- 4. Websites
- 5. Interviews with experts on the topic

Avoid or limit claims based on personal experience or opinion / social media posts

Rules for conduction:

- 1. Pro Socialism (5 minutes) [Socialism Team]
- 2. Rebuttal (3 minutes) [Capitalism Team]
- 3. Pro Capitalism (5 minutes) [Capitalism Team]
- 4. Rebuttal (3 minutes) [Socialism Team]
- 5. Teams question each other (5 minutes/team) [Both teams]
- 6. Closing statements (3 minutes/team) [Both teams, in the opposite order from opening statements]
- 7. Open up the debate for comments from all students. They can just ask for clarification or present new evidence
- 8. Students vote to indicate which side presented the most convincing argument
- 9. Ask students to raise their hands in favour of Capitalism and Socialism teams.
- 10. Ask if anyone's mind has been changed by the debate—ask them to share what changed their thinking.
- Manage emotions
- Strictly avoid personal attacks

- Follow classroom etiquette: No offensive language or gestures, Respect the audience and teammates
- Stay within the scope of the topic
