# Agenda Item 1: Approval of Eligible Students for the Award of Degree

- The Governing Body reviewed the list of final year B.E. students.
- It was noted that out of **549 students**, **517 students have been declared eligible** for the award of degree.

- 4 Students are awarded BE (Hons.) by the University after meeting all the requirements of VTU.
- 32 students were found not eligible as they have not fulfilled the academic requirements as per VTU norms.
- The Governing Body **approved the list of 517 eligible students** for the award of degree during the Graduation Day scheduled on 18th August 2025 at 4.00 PM.

# Agenda Item 2: Approval of Rank Holders and Gold Medals

- The Governing Body considered the list of rank holders prepared as per VTU/Autonomous regulations.
- It was noted that there are a total of 46 ranks across all branches, which includes:
  - o 6 First Ranks (one topper from each branch).
  - The ranks are distributed in accordance with the rule of awarding 10% ranks of the students who appeared for examination in each branch.
- A total of **34 Gold Medals** will be awarded, sponsored by various philanthropists, faculties, industries, and the management.
- The Governing Body appreciated & approved the list of Rank Holders and the allocation of 34 Gold Medals.
