Minutes of the Anti-Ragging Committee Meeting
Academic Year 2025–26

Date: 17th October 2025 **Time:** 11:00 AM **Venue:** New Board Room, Main Building

The **Anti-Ragging Committee Meeting** for the Academic Year 2025–26 was held on 17th October 2025 at 11:00 AM under the Chairmanship of **Dr. S. Y. Kulkarni**, Additional Director & Principal, BNMIT. The Chairman welcomed all the members and presented the agenda of the meeting.

Minutes of the Meeting

1. The Chairman introduced the committee members and outlined their roles and responsibilities as per the AICTE and UGC guidelines.
2. He emphasized the need to increase the frequency of visits to both boys' and girls' hostels, as well as various locations on the campus, to ensure that newly admitted students feel comfortable, secure, and free from any incidents of ragging.
3. The Chairman advised senior faculty members of all departments to remain vigilant and ensure that no incidents of ragging occur in classrooms or departmental premises.
4. He appreciated the strict vigilance and supervision maintained by faculty and staff, which has ensured a ragging-free campus. He particularly appreciated **Sri Hariprasad**, Physical Education Director, and his team for continuously monitoring student interactions in common areas such as the canteen, library, and corridors. He urged them to continue their efforts to maintain a safe, disciplined, and ragging-free environment.
5. The Chairman also introduced the concept of study hours in both boys' and girls' hostels and stressed the importance of maintaining discipline during these sessions.
6. **Prof. T. J. Ramamurthy**, Director, BNMIT, mentioned that since the establishment of the college in 2001, BNMIT has successfully maintained a ragging-free campus due to continuous monitoring and preventive measures.
7. **Dr. B. S. Anil Kumar**, Convener of the Anti-Ragging Committee, briefed the members about various preventive measures implemented by the institution. The following initiatives were highlighted:

- i) Posters with anti-ragging slogans have been displayed at prominent locations across the campus and hostels to create awareness.
 - ii) The Anti-Ragging Week was observed at BNM Institute of Technology from 12th to 18th August 2025 to create awareness about the harmful effects of ragging, its legal consequences, and to promote a safe and inclusive campus environment through various orientation programs conducted across the campus, including classrooms, canteen, and hostels.
 - iii) Information containing the names and contact numbers of the Anti-Ragging Committee and Squad members has been made available on the college website for easy access.
8. **Dr. Subodh Kumar Panda**, Member of the Anti-Ragging Squad, presented the squad report, which indicated that no incidents of ragging have been reported in the hostels or on campus since the college's inception in 2001.
 9. **Sri Bhargavram S G**, parent of **Pranav Jois**, a fifth-semester Mechanical Engineering student, appreciated the effective functioning of various student clubs such as NCC, Sports, and Cultural activities. He also suggested initiating measures to build confidence among students coming from Tier-II and Tier-III cities.
 10. **Ms. Dimpana Yadav**, a third-year student from the Department of Mechanical Engineering, stated that BNMIT maintains a cordial relationship between seniors and juniors, supported by academic interactions and technical club activities. She suggested introducing **spoken English classes** for students from diverse backgrounds to help boost their confidence.
 11. **Mr. Kotresh**, Circle Inspector of Police, BSK 2nd Stage, assured that students can approach the police without hesitation regarding any ragging-related concerns. He also confirmed that regular police patrolling would continue after college hours to ensure student safety and discipline.
 12. The committee suggested that the Anti-Ragging Squad should also monitor areas outside the campus, such as bus stops and nearby parking spaces where students tend to gather.
 13. The committee further recommended giving special attention to students who are physically or mentally weak. It was also advised that parents of students who are irregular to classes should be informed immediately.

14. The Chairman thanked all committee members for their continuous support in fostering a safe, healthy, and ragging-free academic environment at BNMIT.
